## ON THE MUSCLE

On the Muscle is designed to assist with the muscular soreness found in athletic performance horses.

Like human athletes, horses in competitive training get sore muscles. Sometimes this muscle soreness becomes chronic and extends to many parts of the body. This chronic pain often goes unattended and has adverse affects on the training, performance and attitude of the horse.

## Supple Horse

One of the chief causes of chronic lameness and poor performance in the horse is Degenerative Joint Disease (DJD). Signs of possible DVD include: taking a long time to warm up, weakness in hindquarters, resistance to training, inability to collect.

Supple Horse is a time tested herbal mix for the management of DJD, arthritis inflammation and pain.

This classical herbal formulation was designed for humans during the Tang Dynasty in China, about 1200 years ago. The formulation was ,and still is, used to support conditions of the knees, joints, and age related degenerative pain. Also used for joint pain due to cold and/or damp conditions, or aggravated by inactivity.

Especially recommended for horses with stiffness in movement and who respond well to heat therapy at painful joint areas. For external treatment of joints use in conjunction with “Joint Relief Salve”.

**Ingredients:** Loranthus, Notopterygium, Angelica (DuoHuo) Eucommia, Poria, Achyranthes, Gentiana, Clematis, Morinda, Psoralea, Ligusticum, Angelica (Dang Gui), Ledebouriella, Drynaria, Cinnamon, Acanthopanax, Epimedium.

## LIVER QI

The liver is responsible for detoxification of the blood, harmonizing digestion, and regulating the smooth flow of Qi (pronounced, chee).

Often times trainers and owners resort to using tranquilizers and sedative drugs “to take the edge off” the horse. These drugs block nerve impulses as long as the drugs are in the system as well as creating long term health problems.

This herbal combination quiets the mind and spirit, without causing dullness. Quiet Mind helps the horse settle down naturally and relax, so that you can unlock their full potential. This formula has been used successfully since the 16th Century.
